



# 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Player Networking Event

## COVID-19 POLICY

The Player Networking Event (PNE) will comply with federal, state, and all NFL-related recommendations which may impact scheduling, programming, and event attendance (see CDC link on small and large gatherings for more information <https://pneinfo.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/12/CDC-Info.pdf>).

Individuals, athletes, vendors, guests, staff and volunteers will not attend the Player Networking Event (PNE) if they have tested positive for COVID-19 14 days prior to the PNE, or, **unless they are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (as defined by the CDC)**, any of the following is true on the Event date:

- (a) within the prior 14 days, they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or are subject to a federal or local travel or quarantine advisory due to COVID-19;

AND

- (b) within the prior 48 hours, they have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain/achiness, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue or any other symptoms identified by the CDC) (anyone who is fully vaccinated but experiences any of the above symptoms within 48 hours before the Event should nevertheless consult a healthcare provider and get tested for COVID-19 before attending).

PNE will make every attempt to adhere to the protocols outlined below.

- Encouraging attendees to get vaccinated.
- Ensuring that all event attendees receive electronic notice of this policy.
- Taking temperatures during vendor registration and check-in.
- Providing event attendees with masks.
- Encouraging attendees to wash hands upon arrival.
- Asking guests who appear to be sick to leave the event.
- Arranging sanitation stations.
- Practicing social distancing.
- Working with the venue to maximize ventilation.
- Wiping down high traffic areas.
